During regularly scheduled practices the week of January 28th, SHY will Rock the Blocks! SHY Rock the Blocks is a new swim team fundraiser whose donations will benefit the Somerset County YMCA 2019 Annual Campaign. Here's how 100% of our team's donations will make a difference at SHY:

- \$150 = 8 weeks of swim lessons for a child or adult
- \$500 = 1-year membership for a 7th grader
- \$1,000 = 2 weeks of summer camp for two disadvantaged children
- \$3,000 = 2 cancer patients each receive a 12-week LIVESTRONG® session
- \$5,000 = 5 Pre-K children each receive one month of free childcare

During SHY Rocks the Blocks, coaches will play rockin' music at practices while athletes swim 4-12 hours and 800-5,500 yards (dependent on their practice group workout schedules)! And we have prizes to award, too!
